## ANIMAL HANDLERS, TRAINER AND WRANGLERS MEMBERSHIP REQUIREMENTS

1. Minimum of ninety (90) working and dispatched days

Please contact EP (604-987-2292) ask for a "155 Days Worked Report," and;

Please contact Cast and Crew (604-437-6363) and ask for a "Hours Worked Report." They can also be emailed at: [infovancouver@castandcrew.com](mailto:infovancouver@castandcrew.com).

There is no charge for any report we require.

If payroll reports are not available, follow these steps;

- One photocopy (no originals) of paystub per page not stapled
- Put in chronological order (oldest photocopied cheque stub being on top through to the most current on the bottom)
- Do not bring in more than one copy of photocopied paystubs

2. A letter of recommendation from an experienced head of department for animal handling, training and/or wrangling with whom the prospective member, as a Permittee, has worked on one or more productions for a minimum of fifteen (15) days. The proof of each day(s) must be highlighted and attached behind the recommendation letter.

Below are permittee requirements, but must be met at the time of your application:

1. 10-08 Application Form
2. Copy of current Driver's License
3. WHMIS certificate
4. Actsafe's Motion Picture General Safety Awareness certificate
5. Signed waiver
